INDIA'S LEADING ENERGY EXPERT

Narendra Taneja is a New Delhi-based energy expert, advisor and commentator. He is rated as India's top expert on national and international energy issues. He serves as Chairman of the Independent Energy Policy Institute, a New Delhi thinktank. He is also the Founder President of the prestigious World Energy Policy Summit (WEPS). He is Adjunct Professor, NTPC School of Business, Noida, India, focussing on energy. He was until recently the Chairman of Energy Security Group of the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) and Chairman of the Energy and Green Economy Working Group (India) of the BRICS Business Council. Mr Taneja is well-known in public life as a thinker, politician and TV debator and conversationist. He is National Spokesperson of the BJP, India's governing party, and adviser on energy and economy. He has authored and edited three books, including "The Far People - A Norwegian Journal", "Mantras for A Golden India" and "Glory. Growth. Goals. - India's Oil and Gas Industry". He has authored thousands of articles and commentaries on energy policy, diplomacy, geopolitics, security and energy poverty and empowerment. He served as the South Asia Bureau Chief for a number of European business newspapers, including international oil and gas newspaper Upstream, Dagens Industri of Sweden and Dagens Naeringsliv of Norway, for over 15 years before quitting journalism. Mr. Taneja is a well-known speaker on energy and national issues. He is regularly invited to speak by universities, thinktanks, conferences, governments and big companies from all parts of the world. He read economics, business, commerce, policy, leadership, diplomacy and international affairs at St John's College, Agra in India and at the University of Oslo and the University of Oxford in Europe. He lives in New Delhi.
